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Why it Matters*

- LGBTQ+ populations report the highest use rates of tobacco, alcohol and other drugs.
- LGBTQ+ youth are 3 to 4 times more likely to be homeless and 2 to 3 times more likely to attempt suicide than their heterosexual peers.
- As agencies that interact with LGBTQ+ communities, we can help to alleviate systematic barriers that LGBTQ+ populations face.
