ESG-CV Funding Update-Sarah Lim

- \$16 million Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) has been approved, expecting disbursement of funds from the state/county in the near future.

- Due to cold weather, there is overflow for the homeless at the Salvation Army, if the Beacon is full. Individuals have been identified and referrals have been made by the Outreach team.

- The City has identified the Old Saver's sight at East Towne Mall as a possible site for a Men's Shelter and are considering purchasing the building. The Education and Advocacy Committee will have a forum to discuss more about the topic.
