# Workgroup Scope

---

To propose a new way to prioritize individuals and families for RRH and PSH openings in Dane CoC to the HSC board of Directors by the end of 2023

# HUD Rules: PSH and RRH Eligibility

---

## Permanent Supportive Housing:

- must serve households with at least one member with a disability
- must meet additional eligibility set forth in the Fiscal Year NOFO in with the project was funded (experiencing chronic homelessness, Dedicated Plus)

## Rapid Rehousing:

- ESG - must meet Category 1 (literally homeless) definition of homelessness
- CoC - can be any of the 4 categories of homelessness, however must also meet additional eligibility set forth in the NOFO (Category 1, 2, and 4)

# HUD Rules: PSH and RRH Prioritization

---

Permanent Supportive Housing - prioritize those experiencing chronic homelessness and have severe service needs

When there are no longer any people experiencing chronic homelessness, prioritize this way:

- 1st Priority - Homeless individuals and families with a disability with long periods of episodic homelessness and severe service needs
- 2nd Priority - Homeless individuals and families with a disability with severe service needs
- 3rd Priority - Homeless individuals and families with a disability coming from places not meant for human habitation, safe haven, or emergency shelter without severe service needs
- 4th Priority - Homeless individuals and families with a disability coming from transitional housing

Rapid Rehousing - HUD has not provided a notice on prioritization of RRH assistance
