


The Homeless Services Consortium (HSC) is a partnership of agencies, funders, advocates, and people with lived experience of homelessness committed to preventing and ending homelessness. The HSC shares the vision that all persons should have the opportunity to secure and maintain safe, stable and affordable housing. Members believe that housing is a human right.



### Statement of Need

**Emergency shelter** is a necessary and important part of the homeless crisis response system. It is a space where people can be safe from the elements while working to obtain permanent housing. Without adequate **emergency shelter beds**, Dane County will see an increase in unsheltered homelessness. Below is a look at the current situation in Dane County.



#### Shelter Guests - Men

The year-to-date nightly average is **302** guests per night. That is **52 guests above the capacity** of the new shelter. In 2024, that number was 279 guests on average.

So far, in 2025, the lowest number of shelter guests was 247 and the **highest number was 363**. That is **113** guests above capacity of the new shelter.

#### Households with Children

Today, there are **55 households with children** (approx. 193 individuals) on the waiting list for shelter. Of those, **10 households** or 35 individuals are sleeping in **unsheltered locations**.
