- Sarah Lim: The State ESG-CV RFP is open.
- Robin: The CDC moratorium was extended through January 31, 2021. \$25 billion rent assistance was authorized through the last stimulus package. Estimated allocation for Madison/Dane County is \$14-15 million. At least 90% must be for rent assistance. Up to 10% can be spent for housing stability services.
