

What is the most requested resource when people call 211?




Monthly Data 2023


RENT GROWTH 2010-2022




MADISON AND ADJACENT COMMUNITIES REPORT HIGHER MEDIAN RENTS


System Performance Measure 5: First Time Homeless


A key indicator of how well a CoC is preventing homeless occurrences for households who have no previous system engagement within 24 months of enrollment (new) and those who have had an enrollment within 24 months (not new).

Includes data from Emergency Shelter, Safe Haven and Transitional Housing May reveal opportunities for intervention or the success and reach of current interventions.




Annual Housing Data
