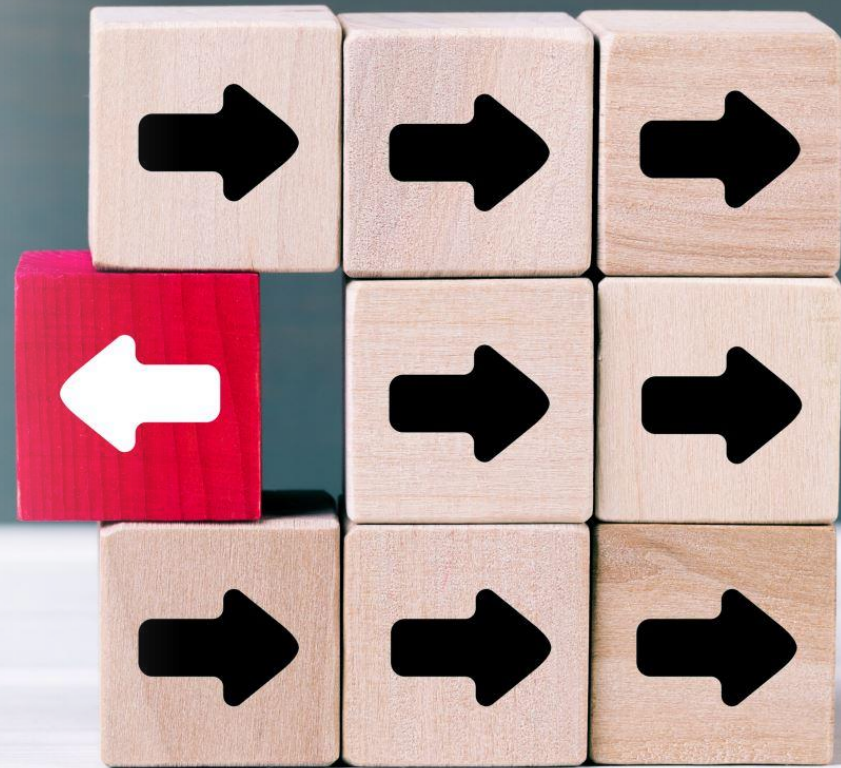


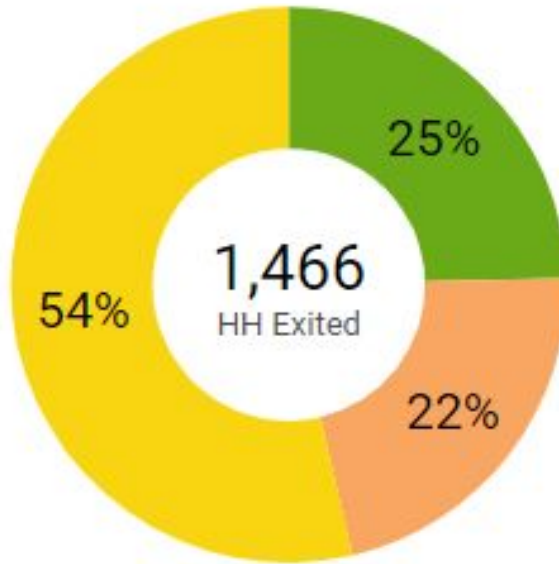
# Exits to Permanent Destinations

Percent of households that exited to permanent, temporary, and unknown destinations by household type.



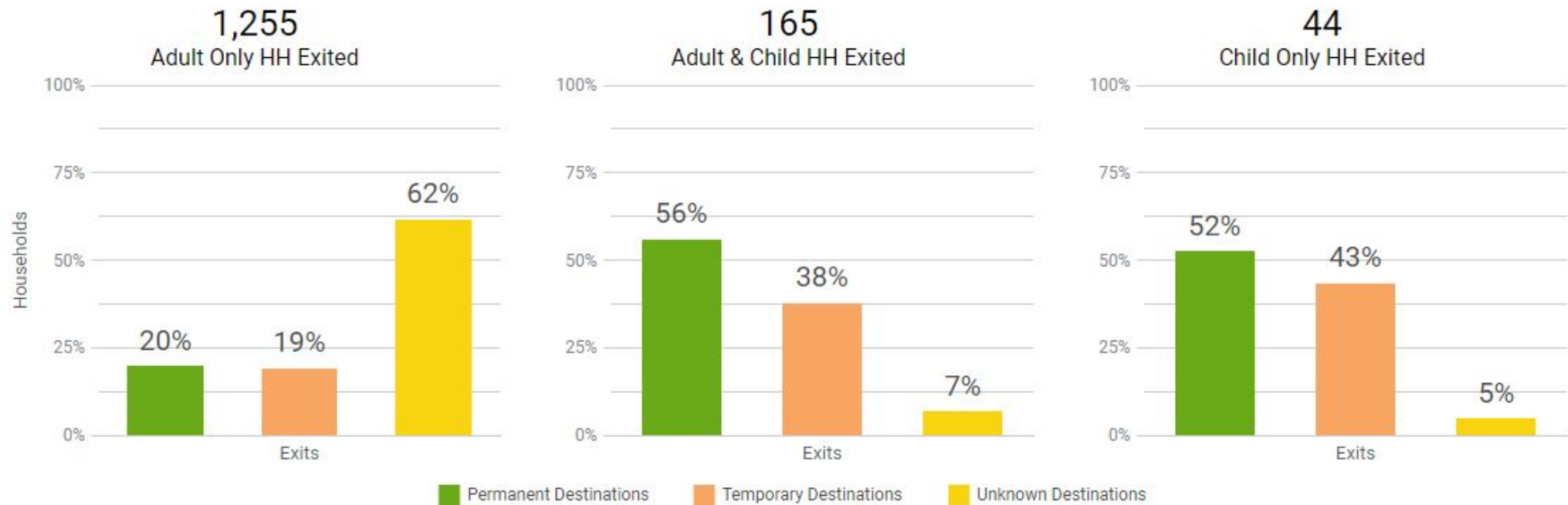
Green = Exit to Permanent Destination

FY2023 – All Exits by Destination Type

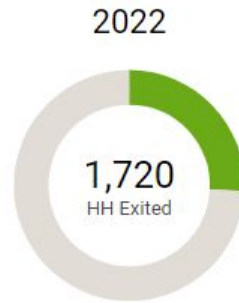
## All Exit Destinations by Household Type



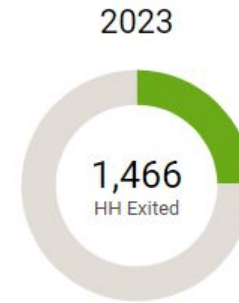
# Exits to Permanent Destinations – Trendlines



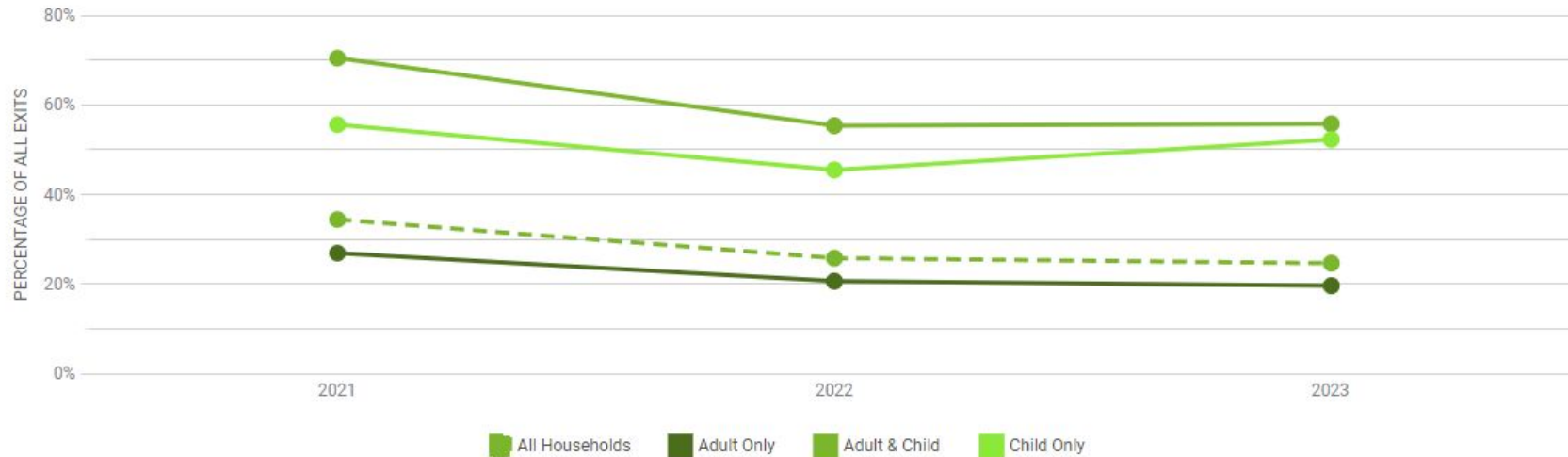

# Exits : Singles

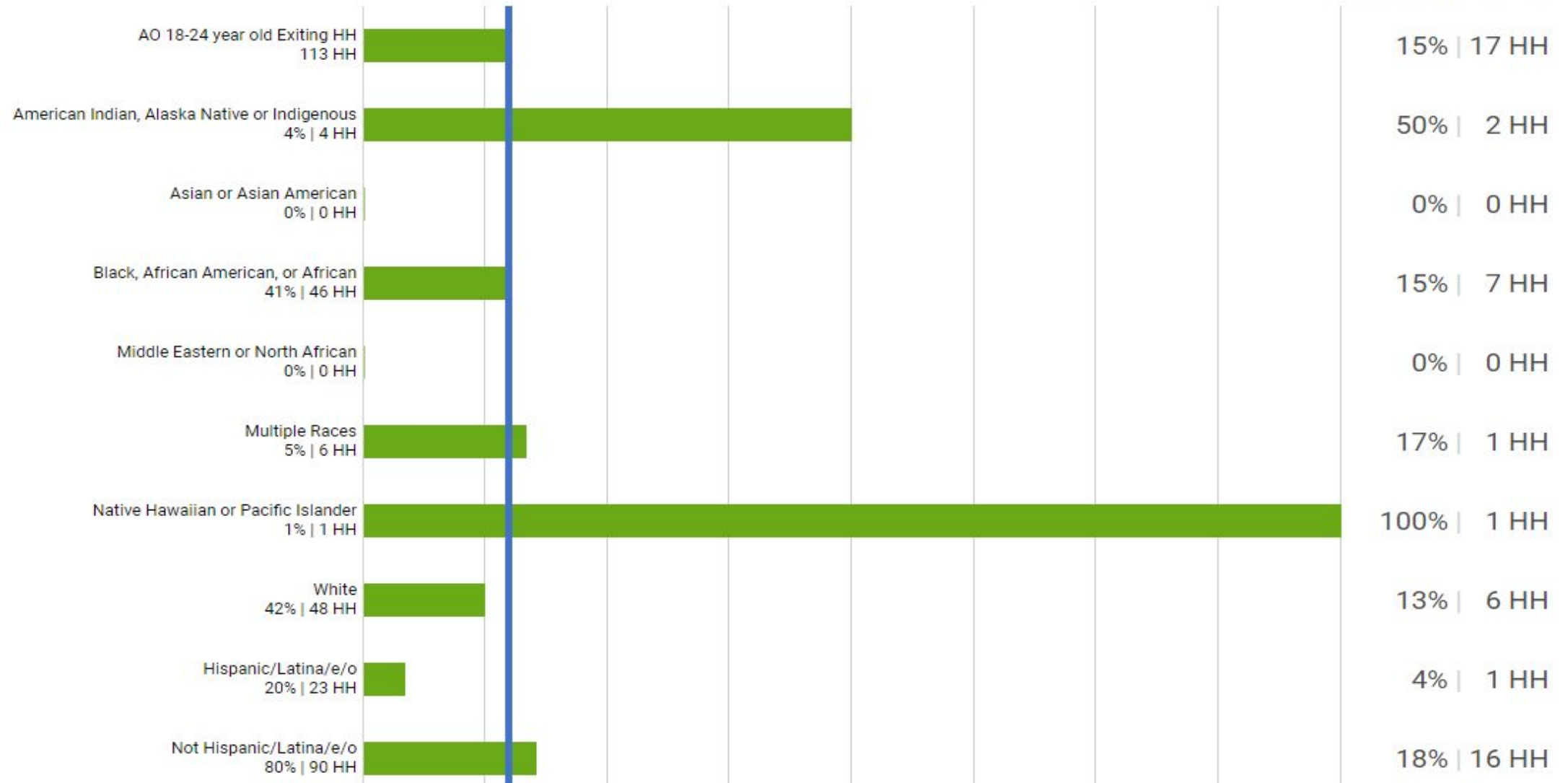
20% Exited to Permanent Destinations (blue line)



# Exits : Singles, Age 18-24

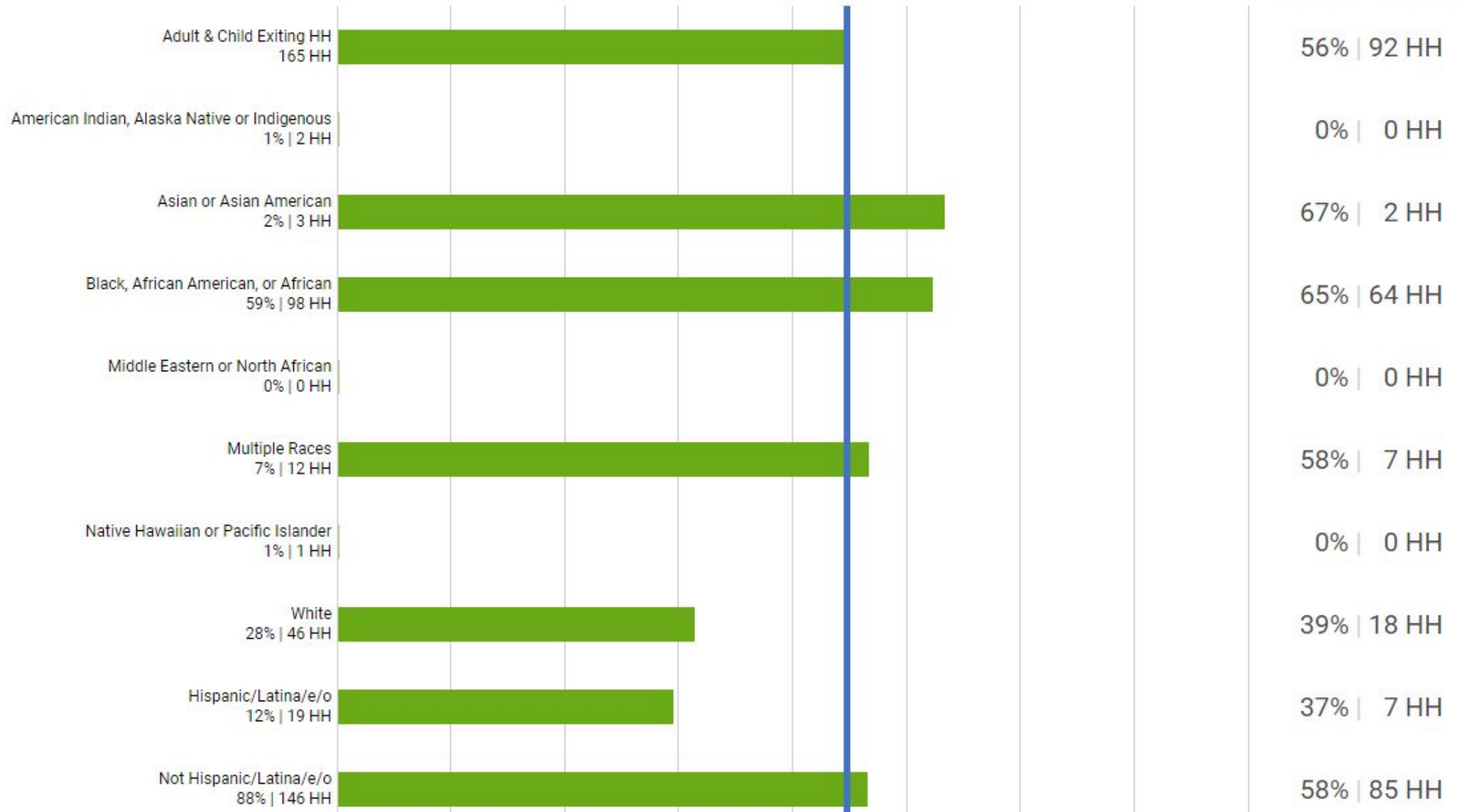
15% Exited to Permanent Destinations (blue line)

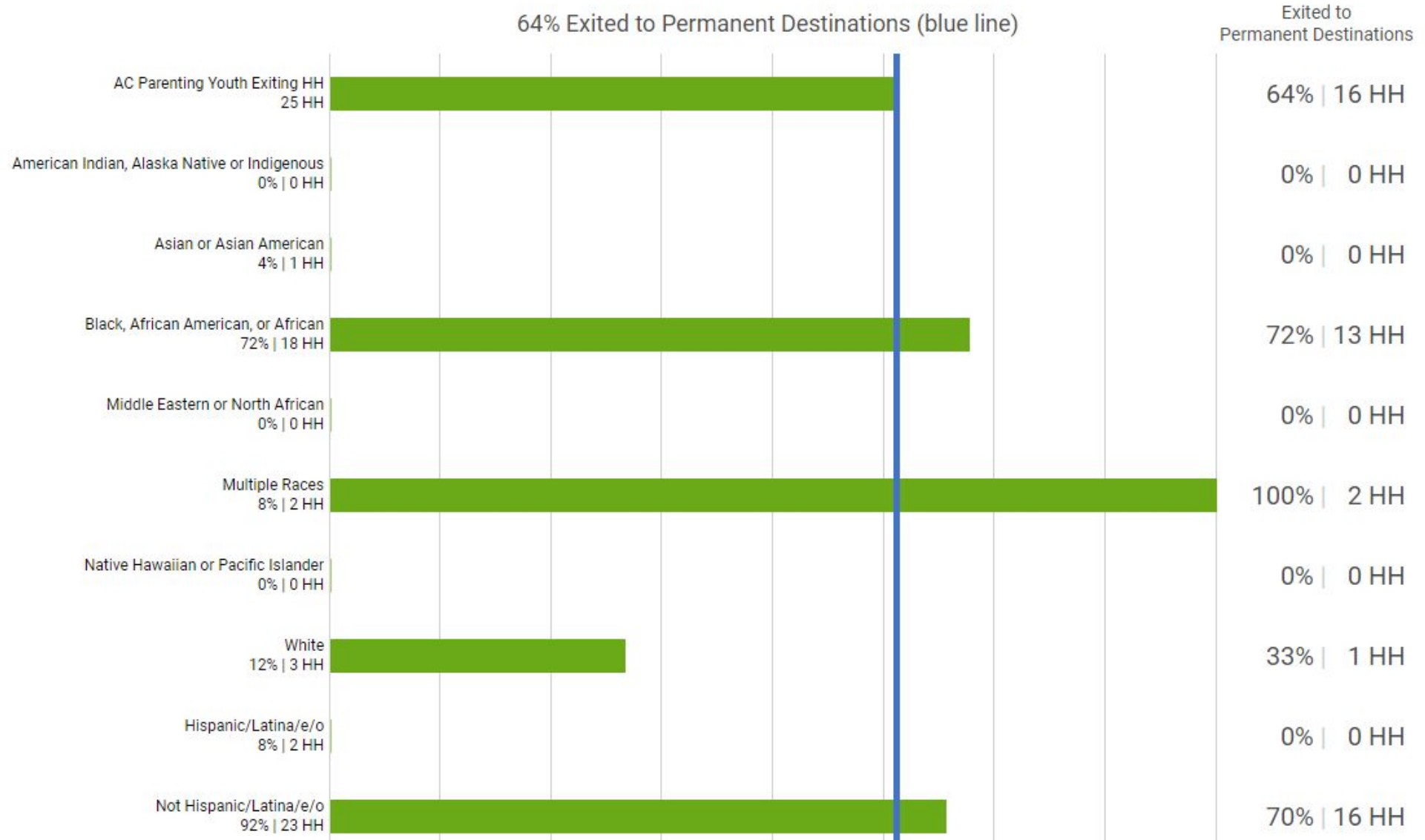
# Exits : Families with Children

# Why is it important? (This slide is unfinished)

- With 54% of households exiting to unknown destinations, it shows how important it is to input that data into our system. There's so much we don't know and finding out some of that information can help better inform programming going forward.
