

Percent of households that exited to permanent, temporary, and unknown destinations by household type.




Green = Exit to Permanent Destination

Orange = Exit to Temporary Destination


Yellow = Exit to Unknown Destination

#### Exits to Permanent Destinations – Trendlines




## Exits : Singles, Age 18-24

## Exits : Families with Children, Parenting Youth Age 18-24


