- TSA women's shelter served 82 people this week. The past max capacity was 65. With families not being at the building, they can accommodate 72 people in the upstairs rooms and more people can be accommodated in the gym. Currently 10 beds in the gym.
- VP hotel and medical respite center are expected to operate until June 2022 (funding is yet to be finalized through the county budget process).
