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# Three Report Submissions

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- LSA (Longitudinal System Analysis)
- System Performance Measures (SPM)
- Point-in-Time and Housing Inventory Count (PIT/HIC)

# LSA

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## ➤ Submission Period

- Late October – Late November (estimated)

## ➤ What is it?

- The LSA data provided by CoCs contains community-level information on people and households served by continuum projects over the course of one year.

## ➤ Projects Included

- Emergency Shelter, Transitional Housing, Rapid Re-housing, Permanent Supportive Housing and other Permanent Housing

# LSA Data

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- Demographic characteristics like age, race, gender, and veteran status
- Length of time homeless and patterns of system use
- Information specific to populations whose needs and/or eligibility for services may differ from the broader homeless population, such as veterans and people and households experiencing chronic homelessness
- Housing outcomes for those who exit the homeless services system.

# LSA - Agency Data to Fix

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- All Projects
  - Household composition
    - Correct family members included
    - Correct Head of Household (HoH)
  - Program Enrollment and Exit Dates
  
- Emergency Shelter
  - Program Exit Date matches last Date of Attendance (Shelter Stay)
  
- Permanent Housing
  - Housing Move-in Date

# System Performance Measures

## ➤ Submission Period

- October 1, 2021 – February 28, 2022

## ➤ What is it?

- HUD has developed the following seven system-level performance measures to help communities gauge their progress in preventing and ending homelessness:
  1. Length of time persons remain homeless
  2. The extent to which persons who exit homelessness to permanent housing destinations return to homelessness
  3. Number of homeless persons
  4. Jobs and income growth for homeless persons in CoC Program-funded projects
  5. Number of persons who become homeless for the first time
  6. Homelessness prevention and housing placement of persons defined by Category 3 of HUD's homeless definition in CoC Program-funded projects
  7. Successful housing placement
- The purpose of these measures is to provide a more complete picture of how well a community is preventing and ending homelessness

## ➤ Projects Included

- Street Outreach, Emergency Shelter, Transitional Housing, Rapid Re-housing, Permanent Supportive Housing and other Permanent Housing

# SPM - Agency Data to Fix

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## ➤ All Projects

- Household composition
  - Correct family members included
  - Correct Head of Household (HoH)
- Program Enrollment and Exit Dates

## ➤ Permanent Housing

- Housing Move-in Date

## ➤ HUD CoC Program Projects

- Annual Assessments (focus on income)

# PIT/HIC

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- Submission Period
  - February – April (estimated)
  
- What is it: Point in Time
  - Count of all persons in emergency shelter and transitional housing
  - Count of all unsheltered persons
  
- What is it: Housing Inventory Count
  - Count of all available inventory in the community. Includes emergency shelter, transitional housing, rapid re-housing, permanent supportive housing and other permanent housing.
