I. Resource availability for doubled up households

II. Public Record Deletion updates

- a. WI. Courts said they are positive that deletions are happening as files are eligible.
 - i. The deletions occur weekly on Sunday evenings and all eligible cases are deleted.
 - ii. If cases are not deleted, it is because one of the following:
 - 1. Case was reopened
 - 2. There is a balance on the judgment
 - 3. A writ or stipulation was ordered

III. Shelter provider communications / updating doubled up status.

- a. Agencies encouraged to tell clients to keep their housing status updated with shelter waitlist.
 - i. If the household is doubled up when they go on the waitlist, they should contact the shelter and update their housing status if they become literally homeless.
