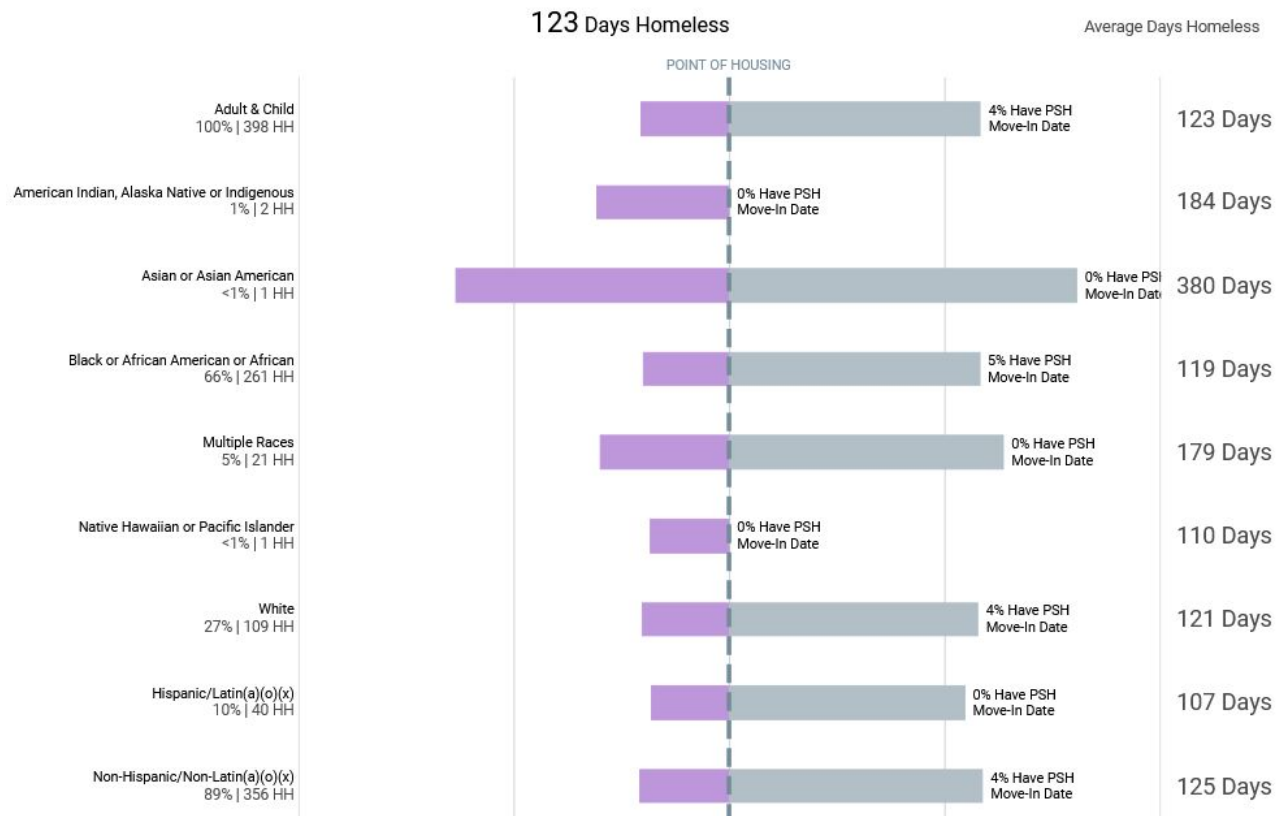

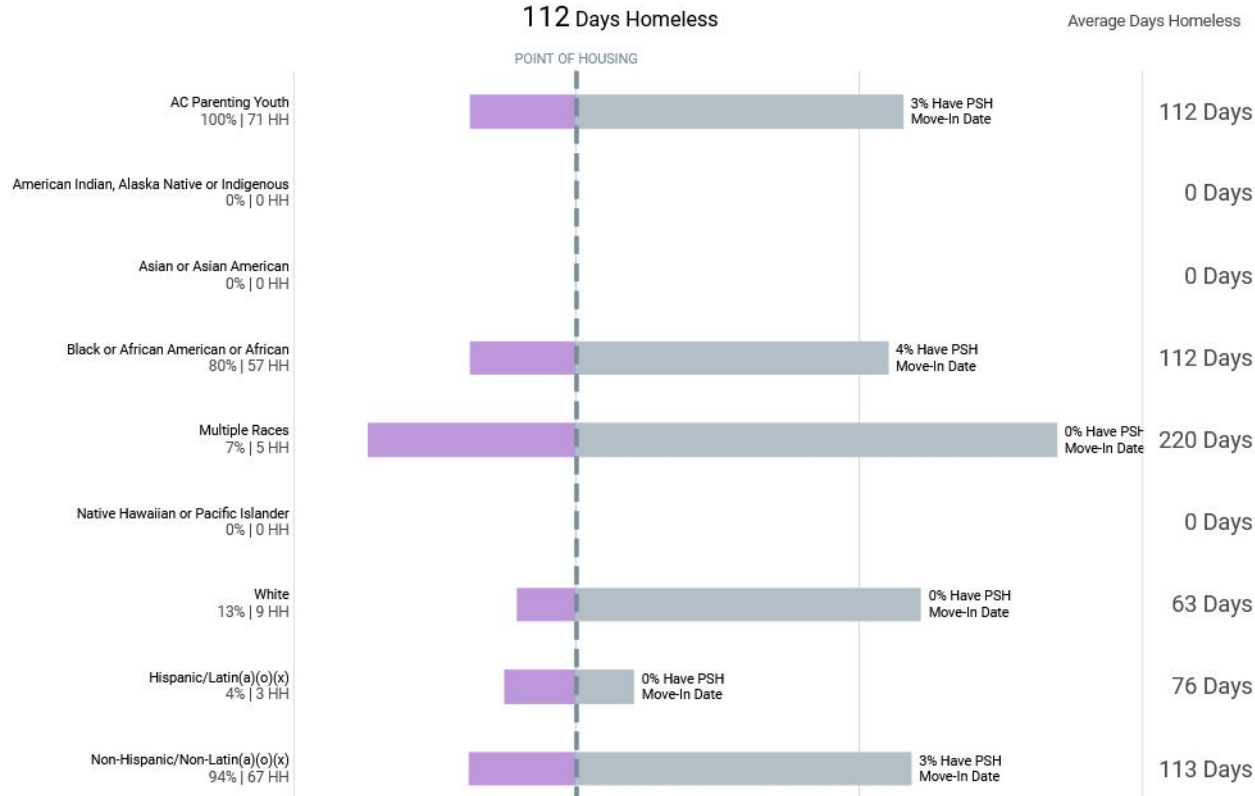
Days Homeless: Families with Children



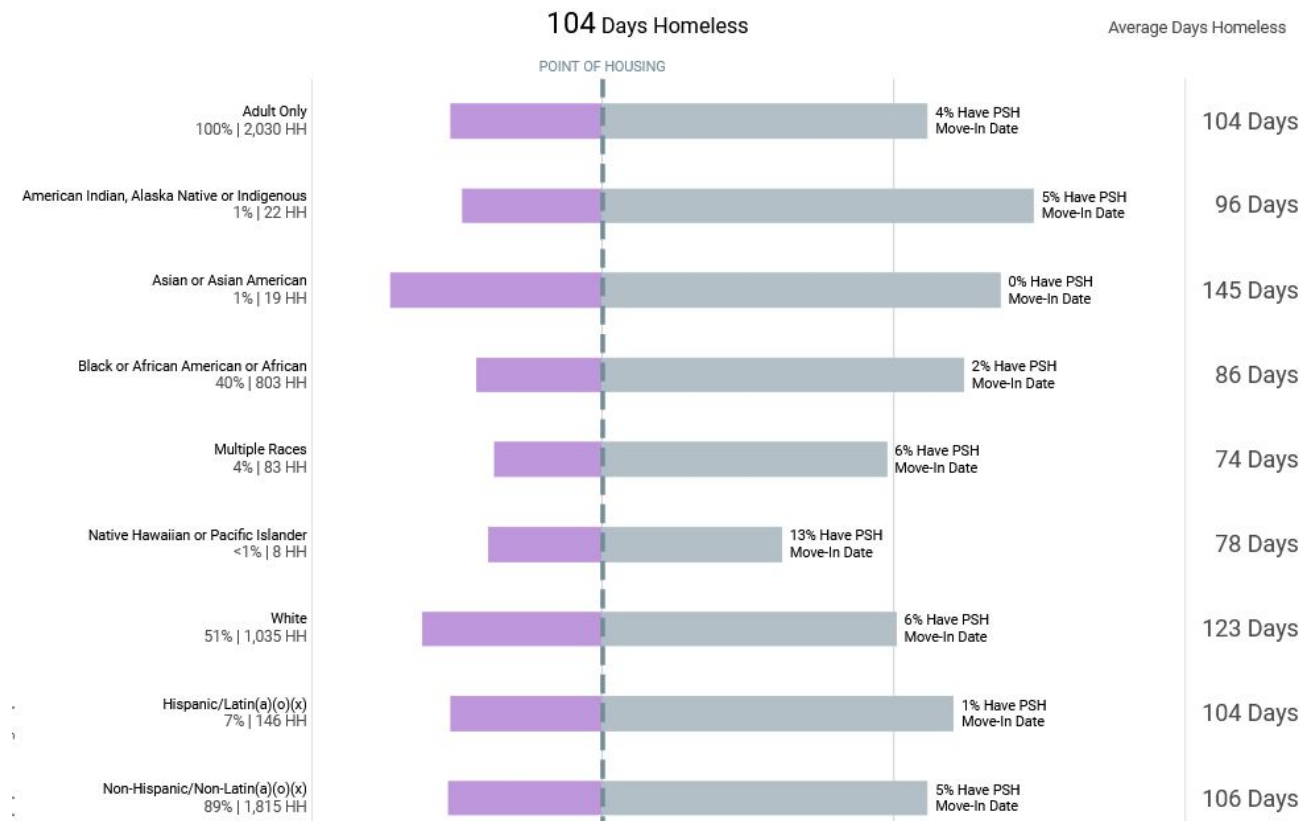
Purple bar: The average cumulative, unduplicated # of days that households were served in shelter or transitional housing programs; and days in RRH or PSH prior to move

Days Homeless: Families with Children, Parenting Youth Age 18-24



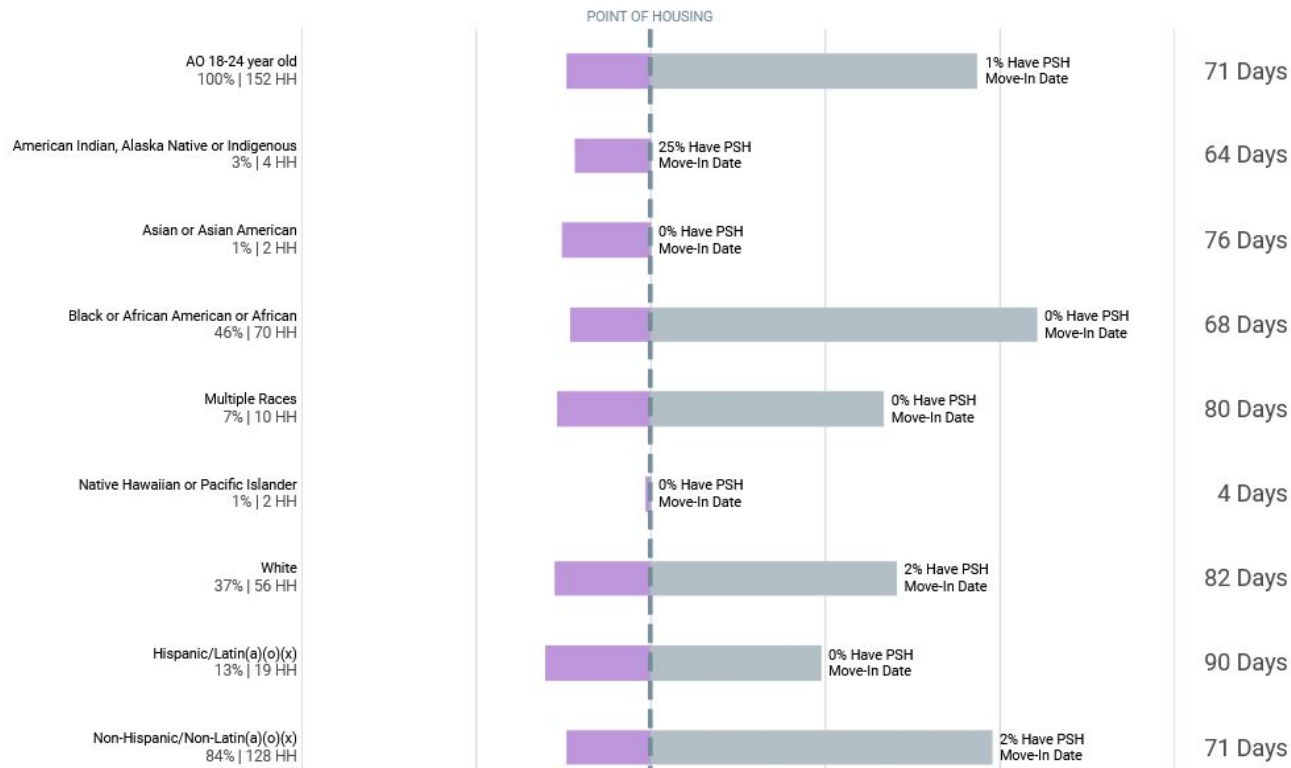
Days Homeless: Singles

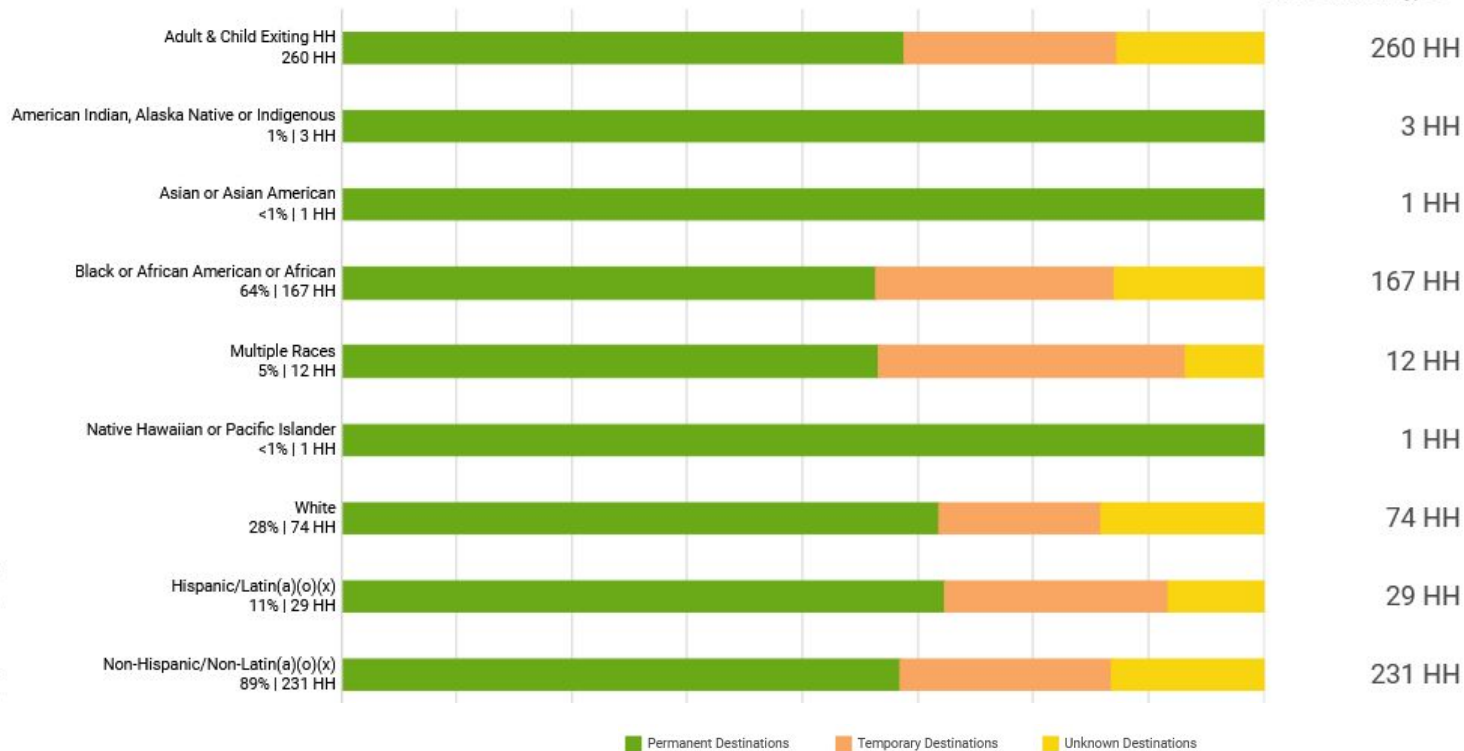

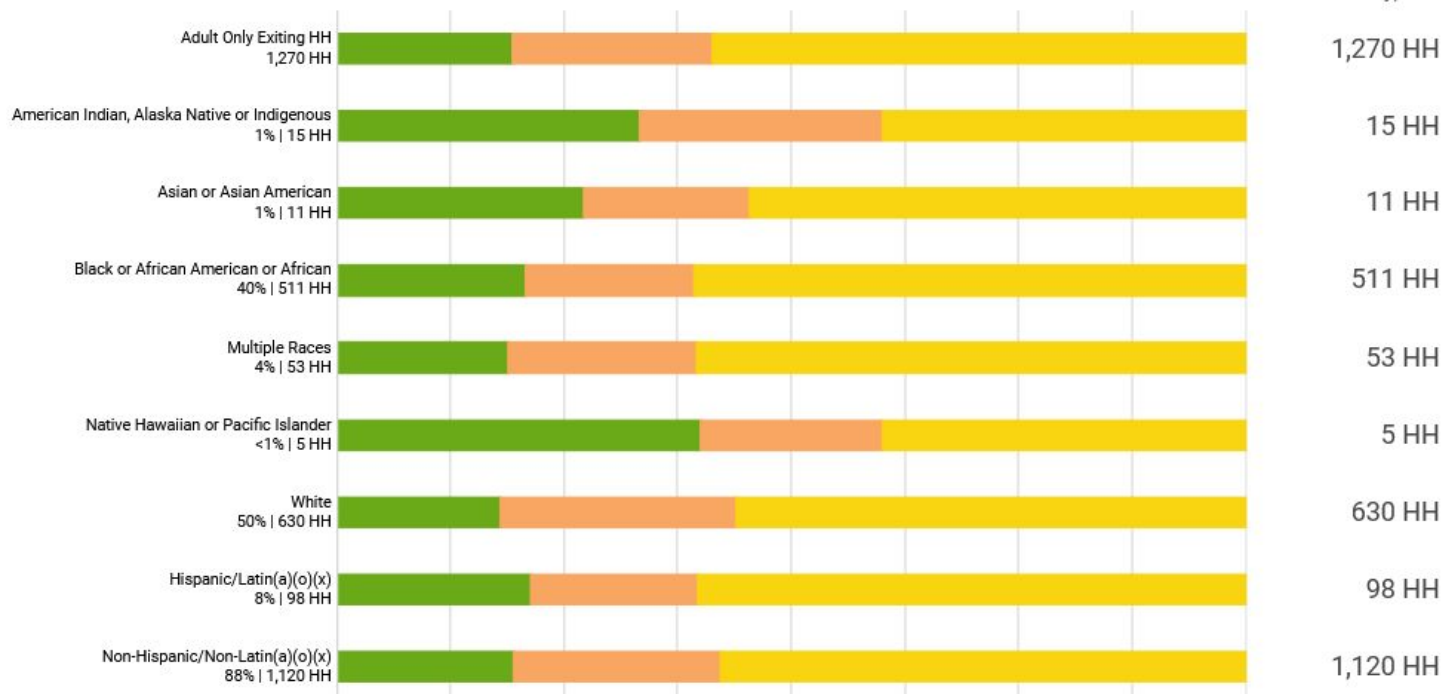

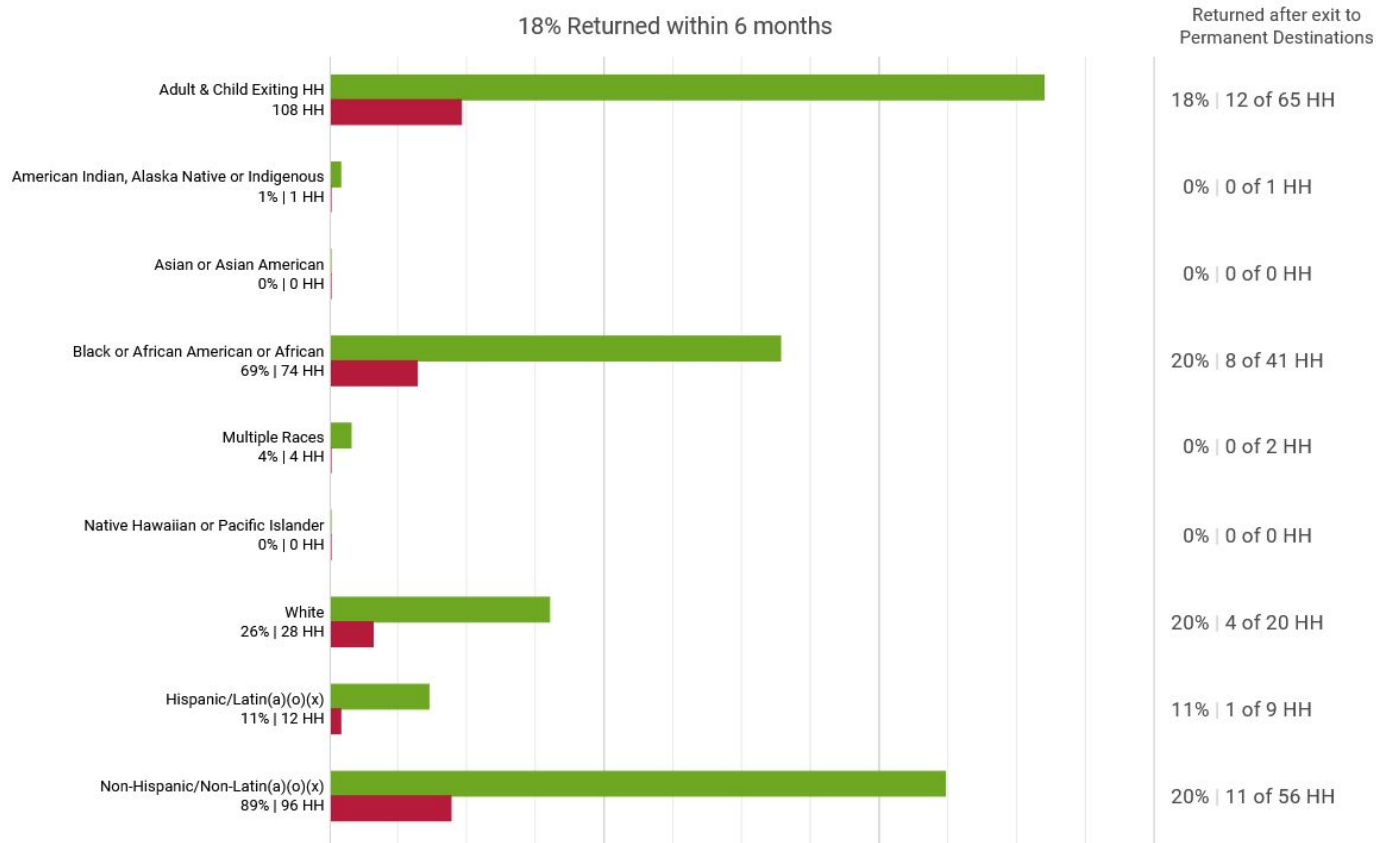

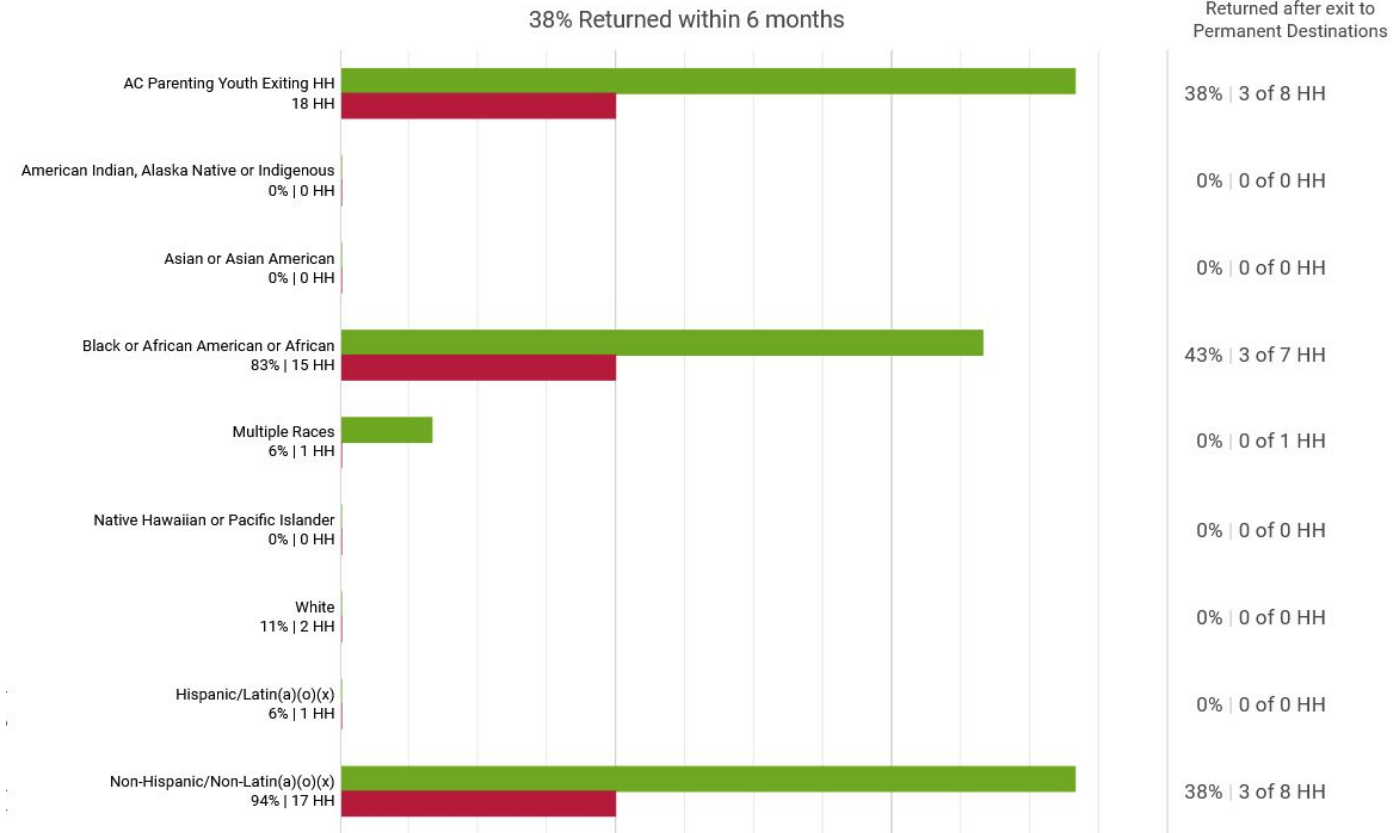

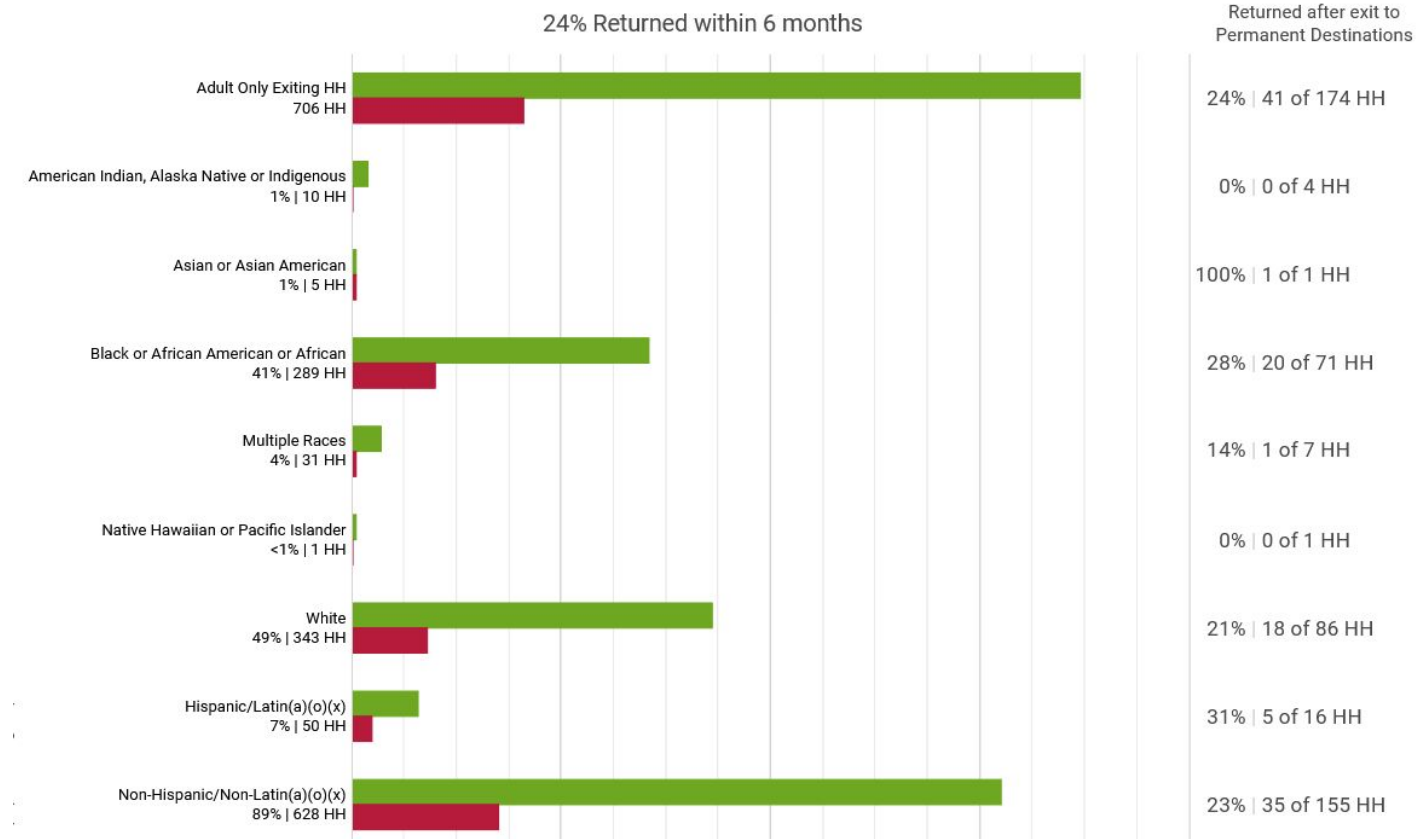

Return to Homeless: Families with Children, Parenting Youth Age 18-24

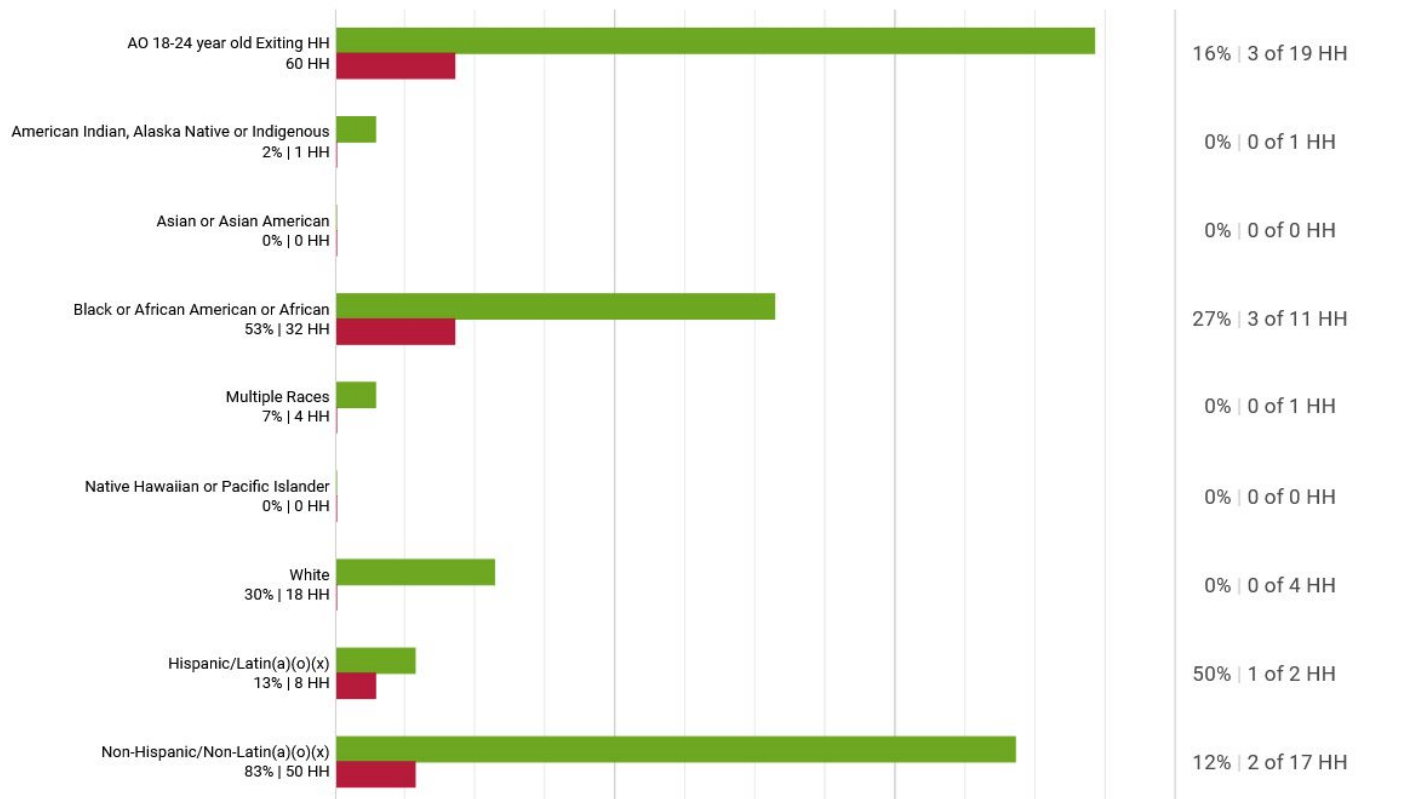
